The Beasties by William Sleator

When 15-year-old Doug and his little sister Colette move with their parents to a house on the edge of a forest, they encounter some strange, scary creatures that live in the wilderness.

Beating Heart: a ghost story by AM Jenkins

After his parents' divorce, seventeen-year-old Evan moves with his mother and sister into an old house where the spirit of a young woman who died there awakens and mistakes him for her long-departed lover.

Blood and Chocolate by Annette Curtis Klause

Every full moon, sixteen-year-old Vivian turns into a wolf. She longs for a normal life, but is unsure of what can ever be considered normal for a werewolf. When Vivian falls in love with human Aiden, her loyalties are divided. A brutal murder threatens to expose her pack, and Vivian is forced to decide where she belongs.

Blue Bloods by Melissa de la Cruz

Teenagers from some of New York City's wealthiest families learn a startling secret about their bloodlines when, at age 15, they start craving raw meat and having nightmares about historical events.

A Certain Slant of Light by Laura Whitcomb

After haunting a series of people for 130 years, Helen meets a teenage boy who can see her and together they unlock the mysteries of their pasts.

Coraline by Neil Gaiman

When Coraline steps through a door to find another house strangely similar to her own, she has to fight with all her wits and courage if she's going to save herself and return to her real life.

Demonata series: Lord Loss (book 1) by Darren Shan

Grubbs Grady is the only witness to the brutal slaughter of his family. Now he must outwit both the mental health professionals who want to cure his "delusions" and the demonic forces that only he can see.

Demonata series: Demon Thief (book 2) by Darren Shan

Grubbs discovers his powers as a Disciple and his mission to hunt the viciously powerful Demonata to the death.

Demonata series: Slawtr (book 3) by Darren Shan

While on a horror movie set with his Uncle Dervish, Grubbs realizes that his battle with the evil demon Lord Loss may be about to resume.

Demonata series: Bec (book 4) by Darren Shan

As the demonic Fomorii ravage their land, Bec and her warriors leave to answer a call for help and to find information that will enable Bec to unlock the secrets of her past.

Fear Street series by RL Stine

The Haunting of Alaizabel Cray by Chris Wooding

As Thaniel, a wych-hunter, and Cathaline, his friend and mentor, try to rid London's Old Quarter of the terrible creatures that infest them, their lives become entwined with that of a woman who may be either mad or possessed.

The Mediator series: Shadowland (book 1) by Meg Cabot

Suze is a mediator - a liaison between the living and the dead. When she and her mother move to California, Suze has to deal not only with her new stepbrothers but also a handsome, 150-year-old ghost named Jesse in her bedroom and an angry girl ghost at her new school.

The Mediator series: Ninth Key (book 2) by Meg Cabot

When Tad Beaumont, the hottest guy in town, asks Suze out, she's so excited that she's willing to ignore

her misgivings about Tad. What she can't ignore, however, is the ghost of a murdered woman whose death seems directly connected to dark secrets in Tad's past.

The Mediator series: Reunion (book 3) by Meg Cabot

Four ghostly teens who died in a terrible car accident blame Suze's classmate Michael and they'll stop at nothing until he joins them in the realm of the dead. As Suze's fends off their attempts on Michael's life, she discovers that their deaths weren't accidental at all and their killer is willing to strike again.

The Mediator series: Darkest House (book 4) by Meg Cabot

When the 19th century ghost of Maria de Silva wakes her up in the middle of the night with a knife to her throat, Suze knows it's no ordinary visitation. Maria was Jesse's fiancée – the same ghostly Jesse that Suze is in love with. There's construction going on in Suze's backyard and Maria doesn't want something (or someone) to be found. But if she solves Jesse's murder, will Suze lose him forever?

The Mediator series: Haunted (book 5) by Meg Cabot

When Suze meets Paul, another mediator, he threatens to send Jesse to the Great Beyond unless she'll go out with him.

The Mediator series: Twilight (book 6) by Meg Cabot

When Suze and Paul discover that their powers can also be used to determine whether people become ghosts in the first place, Suze is torn at the thought that Jesse's murder could be prevented, but it would mean that they'd never meet

New Moon by Stephenie Meyer

In this sequel to *Twilight*, Edward and his family leave Forks rather than risk revealing they are vampires. Bella is devastated, but she finds solace until in her friend Jacob she's drawn into a kind of cult and changes in horrible ways.

Night of the Bat by Paul Zindel

Jake joins his father on an expedition to study bats in the Brazilian rain forest and finds the project menaced by a giant brain-eating bat.

Peeps by Scott Westerfeld

Cal Thompson is a carrier of a parasite that causes vampirism and must hunt down the girlfriends he may have infected.

The Presence by Eve Bunting

While visiting her grandmother in California, seventeen-year-old Catherine comes in contact with a mysterious stranger who says he can help her contact a friend who died in a car crash for which Catherine feels responsible.

The Saga of Darren Shan (Cirque du Freak) series: Cirque Du Freak (book 1) by Darren Shan

Darren Shan is an ordinary schoolboy, until he and his best friend Steve get tickets to the Cirque Du Freak, a bizarre freak show. In the midst of the ghoulish excitement, true terror raises its head when Steve recognizes that one of the performers - Mr. Crepsley - is in fact a vampire! Later, in a moment of insane daring, Darren sets out to steal the vampire's magnificent performing tarantula, an act that will have tragic consequences for both boys.

The Saga of Darren Shan (Cirque du Freak) series: The Vampire's Assistant (book 2) by Darren Shan

After traveling with Mr. Crepsley, Darren returns to Cirque Du Freak and continues to fight his need to drink human blood.

The Saga of Darren Shan (Cirque du Freak) series: Tunnels of Blood (book 3) by Darren Shan

Darren, Evra, and Mr. Crepsley leave Cirque Du Freak for the city, but when corpses drained of blood start turning up, the two boys must confront a dangerous creature of the night.

The Saga of Darren Shan (Cirque du Freak) series: Vampire Mountain (book 4) by Darren Shan

Mr. Crepsley takes Darren on a dangerous trek to Vampire Mountain to be presented to the Council.

The Saga of Darren Shan (Cirque du Freak) series: Trials of Death (book 5) by Darren Shan

Darren begins the Trials of Initiation to prove himself worthy of being a half-vampire, as the clan's blood foes, the vampaneze, gather near Vampire Mountain.

The Saga of Darren Shan (Cirque du Freak) series: The Vampire Prince (book 6) by Darren Shan

Betrayed by Kurda and reeling from the slaying of Gavner, Darren finds himself branded a traitor and being hunted by the clan.

The Saga of Darren Shan (Cirque du Freak) series: Hunters of the Dusk (book 7) by Darren Shan

Darren leaves Vampire Mountain as part of an elite force on a mission to find the newly risen Vampaneze Lord who is set to lead the vampaneze into war against the vampires.

The Saga of Darren Shan (Cirque du Freak) series: Allies of the Night (book 8) by Darren Shan

Darren's determination is tested as he and the Hunters travel to Mr. Crepsley's hometown in search of the murderous vampaneze.

The Saga of Darren Shan (Cirque du Freak) series: Killers of the Dawn (book 9) by Darren Shan

As his battle against the vampaneze continues, Darren is framed as Public Enemy Number One.

The Saga of Darren Shan (Cirque du Freak) series: The Lake of Souls (book 10) by Darren Shan

To unlock the mysteries of his past, Harkat and Darren must place themselves in the hands of Mr. Tiny and leave the world of humanity behind.

The Saga of Darren Shan (Cirque du Freak) series: Lord of the Shadows (book 11) by Darren Shan

Darren's going home. The town's changed a lot in the years that he's been away - but then, so has Darren. Plagued by nightmares of what the future seems to hold, Darren feels uneasy revisiting the place where he was re-born as a child of the night.

The Saga of Darren Shan (Cirque du Freak) series: Sons of Destiny (book 12) by Darren Shan

The Hunters must face Steve Leopard, to fight for control of the night. Will Steve emerge victorious and wipe out the vampire clan? Or will the Hunters prevail? If the vampires triumph, Darren is destined to become the Lord of the Shadows and destroy humanity. Can Darren fight Des Tiny?
